Fifth Sunday of Easter - Year B



Fr. Mark writes: 'When Saul got to Jerusalem he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him: they could not believe he was really a disciple.' Their reaction is scarcely surprising. Saul had been persecuting them and trying to destroy Christianity. Think, however, how much would have been lost without the Apostle Paul – the founding of so many churches, all those letters of the New Testament. Fortunately, spoke in his favour.

It is unlikely that anyone is actively excluded from joining the Church, but it may be an implicit message some come away with. No one should be made to feel unwelcome because they are of a different background or what they might have done or been in the past. Be a Barnabas. The invitation is to all: convert, change, and believe in Our Lord Jesus Christ. We may possibly be welcoming a St Paul.
