## Corpus Christi - Year C



**Fr. Mark writes:** The Gospel is the feeding of the 5,000. It is not simply an encouragement to share our food at a picnic. The account is rather deeply Eucharistic. (In John's Gospel Jesus proceeds from the feeding of the 5,000 to give His great teaching on the Mass.) The feeding 'in a desolate place' puts us in mind of God feeding His people in the wilderness with the miraculous manna, the bread from heaven, in the time of Moses. Jesus raises His eyes to heaven, as the

priest does in the canon of the Mass. There is a superabundance of this bread. Twelve full baskets remain – referring to the twelve tribes of the Old Testament, but also looking forward to the twelve apostles of the Church. Jesus is preparing us for the very gift of Himself, His Body and Blood, in Holy Communion.

#### Corpus Christi – Blessed Sacrament Procession & Parish Picnic

It seems that we won't be troubled by bad weather. Therefore, our Blessed Sacrament procession will take place immediately after the 11.00 am Mass. That Mass will be the Celebration Mass for our First Holy Communion children, who are encouraged to wear their First Holy Communion clothes. We start and finish in the church, making a circuit round Ashchurch Terrace, Ashchurch Park Villas, Goldhawk Road and back into Ashchurch Grove. After Benediction in the church, we go to Ravenscourt Park for a Picnic in the Park – in the railed area between the lake and the children's play area. Please bring food and drink, and ensure all rubbish is cleared away subsequently. This is a wonderful and joyful public act of witness to Jesus, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, something which helps children appreciate their Catholic identity. And we have the opportunity to enjoy one another's company.
