### Second Sunday of Advent - Year A



**Fr. Mark writes:** Both the prophet Isaiah and the psalmist offer a beautiful vision of peace, restitution and reconciliation. This is how it can be – world without war, hatred and greed. The coming of the Christ Child at Christmas is God's decisive intervention to ensure that this vision does not remain at the level of a dream. For it to be achieved, it requires us to accept with reservation the coming of Christ into our lives today. For He will come in glory at the end of

time to implement this vision, to reward each one according to our deeds.

#### Vigil Mass

We welcome Bishop Michael Campbell to the 6.00 pm Mass this Saturday evening. Congratulations to James Burn, whom Bishop Michael is confirming.

#### Rorate Mass

Our annual Rorate Mass at **7.00 am** this **Wednesday, 10 December** – a chanted Mass by candlelight. A beautiful preparation for the coming of the Christ Child as we wait with Our Lady for the dawning sun. You are invited to the Parish House basement subsequently for coffee and croissants.

#### Confession

Confession should be part of our spiritual preparation for Christmas. In addition to the normal times (5.15-5.45 pm on Saturdays and for an hour after the Sunday evening Mass), a visiting priest, Fr. Gerard Sheehan, is available to hear Confessions at all the Sunday Masses next weekend, **13/14 December**.

#### Catholic Primary School Applications

Fr. Mark is available in the Parish House for priest references for primary school applications: **6-8 pm** tomorrow **Monday**, **8 December**; and **6-7 pm** on **Friday**, **9 January**. The parent/carer who attends Mass here should attend. Please bring the Certificate of Catholic Practice (one per school, having completed your child's details) and baptism certificate (if their baptism did not take place here). There is **an appointment system**. To book an appointment, please <u>E-Mail</u> Jack, the catechist, at <u>shepherdsbushcat@rcdow.org.uk</u> indicating which of the sessions you can attend. He will confirm the time. In seeking a reference, you are asking the priest to confirm that your child is a baptised Catholic and you have attended Mass here each Sunday over a number of years. If you have recently moved to the parish or attend Mass more regularly elsewhere, it makes sense to seek a reference from that other parish.

#### **Christmas Offerings**

The attached envelope is for Christmas offerings to the parish. (If you are in the envelope system, you have one already in your box.) In the past, Christmas offerings were a personal gift to the priests of the parish. Like most priests today, I make Christmas and Easter offerings over to the parish in return for a fixed salary. There is still, however, an advantage in using the envelope. Anything given in this way remains for the benefit of our parish, whereas 1/3 of the Sunday collection goes to the Diocese.

#### **Marriage Preparation**

Catholics should marry in church to receive God's graces and blessings which we need for married and family life to flourish. Whether you plan marrying in the UK or overseas in 2026, there is a certain amount of documentation and preparation to be undertaken here. It is relatively straight forward provided a start is made at an early stage. If you plan to marry in 2026, please speak to Fr. Mark. One of the requirements is attendance at a marriage preparation course. We will have a course here over two afternoons, **2-5 pm, Saturday, 31 January** and **7 February**. This is the only course we will provide in the parish in 2026, although it may be possible to attend courses elsewhere.
