Beyond Tyburn: the London Martyrs

Many people fail to appreciate that 'Tyburn Tree' stood at the end of Oxford Street, at the bottom of Edgware Road. Hundreds of Catholics were martyred there, but also elsewhere in London, simply because of their Catholic faith. 300 years later a convent was founded by the site.
